Bank Robbery

At about 1:35 P.M. today, the Pleasanton Police Department received a report that the Bank of America located at 6005 Stoneridge Drive had just been robbed. Responding patrol units quickly arrived and established a perimeter however the suspect fled prior to their arrival. Further investigation revealed that the suspect entered the bank and handed a teller a threatening note. (For investigative purposes, the details of the note are not being released at this time.) After receiving an undisclosed sum the suspect left the bank. Further investigation revealed that the suspect fled in a vehicle.

Suspect Description: Black male, 30 to 40 years old, 5'08" to 5'09" tall, medium build, clean shaven.

Clothing: White hooded sweatshirt with a dark stripe down the back, grey pants, sunglasses.

Suspect Vehicle: Similar to a Brown 1970's Ford Ranchero with a White Camper Shell.
