

**City of Pleasanton Water-Efficient Irrigation Rebate Program  
For Irrigation Customers  
Terms and Conditions  
Program Effective January 1, 2012**

**Funding is limited and on a first-come, first-served basis!**

**Program Goals:**

Reduce outdoor water use and promote a healthy and attractive landscaping by improving watering efficiency through the installation of water-efficient irrigation hardware.

Partner the water-efficient irrigation hardware being rebated through this program with a Weather-Based “Smart” irrigation controller(s) to maximize water efficiency. (*Weather-Based Irrigation Controller Rebate* available through Zone 7, [www.zone7water.com](http://www.zone7water.com))

**Program Specifics:**

- This offer applies only to irrigation meter customers who have an active water account in good standing within the City of Pleasanton.
- Irrigation hardware up for rebate consideration **must be used on landscape area that was or is participating in Zone 7's or City of Pleasanton's Water-Efficient Landscape Program.**
- Site must currently have a weather-based irrigation controller, or be applying for a weather-based irrigation controller through Zone 7 in conjunction with this application.
- Site must have water use history (past 3 years).
- Site must have a well-maintained irrigation system that is in good working order.
- Applicant must install specified hardware per manufacturer's directions.
- Installation must be complete before issue of rebate
- Hardware must remain installed for a minimum of two (2) years.
- All rebates are subject to availability of funds. Rebate processing may take up to 10 weeks.
- Rebate is issued as water bill credit or by check.
- Sales tax, installation, programming costs, and any other fees are not rebated.

**How to Participate:**

- Customer must currently have a fully operational in-ground irrigation system operated by a weather-based controller or converting to a weather-based controller.
- Complete the City of Pleasanton WEIR Application ([www.pleasantonwaterconservation.com](http://www.pleasantonwaterconservation.com))
- Applicant must submit original or copy of receipts including the name of the store or contractor, purchase date, price, make and model.
- Applicant must install the approved hardware per manufacturer's directions **within 60 days of purchase date.**
- Applicant must agree to a pre- and post-inspection.

**Qualifying Equipment and Rebate Amounts:**

Qualifying Irrigation Equipment and Rebate Amounts*	
Rain Sensor	Up to \$50 per sensor
Pressure Regulating Devices servicing converted area	Up to 25%
Water-Efficient Rotary Nozzles (with pressure regulation and/or check valves)	Up to 25%

**Note:** Funding is limited. Rebates are one-time-only per lawn-converted site, and will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
