Students must have English verbal and written skills sufficient enough to register with the program. Applicants participate in a brief interview with Adult Literacy staff and complete Student Registration Form with little or no help. Students must be 18 years of age or older.

- Tutors are all volunteers; there may be a significant waiting period before placement.
- Pleasanton residents will be given priority placement with tutors.
- English Conversation Groups meet weekly at the Library for students to practice their English skills.
- Students may check out English study materials with a Library Card.

Las Positas College offers a comprehensive ESL Program which includes six levels of instruction: two semesters of beginning, two semesters of intermediate, and two semesters of advanced courses. The program focuses on academic language skills: reading, writing, grammar, and oral communication. The College provides assessment, counseling, orientation, and support services, *including free tutoring*, for all enrolled ESL and international students.
