



LOCAL AND STATE WATER BOARD WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

(UPDATED MAY 16, 2016)

Saving Water Every Day with these Required Measures:

- Only water lawns and ornamental landscaping between the hours of 6 p.m. and 9 a.m. the following day; with the exception of drip irrigation and hand watering with a shut-off nozzle equipped hose.
- Water in a manner that does not result in runoff onto non-irrigated areas, such as sidewalks or roadways.
- Watering outdoors is prohibited during and within 48 hours of measureable rainfall.
- The use of potable (drinking) water to wash driveways, sidewalks, or other hardscapes is prohibited; unless necessary for health or safety.
- Wash vehicles only with the use of a hose equipped with a functioning shut-off nozzle. Wash water is prohibited from entering the storm drain system (street gutter).
- All decorative fountains and water features shall be recirculating.
- Repair leaks or breaks within 8 hours of discovery or notification.
- Restaurants shall serve water to their customers only when specifically requested by the customer.
- Operators of hotels/motels shall provide their guests the option of choosing not to launder towels & linens daily.

Recommended Water Conservation Measures:

- Keep swimming pools covered when not in use to prevent evaporation.
- Use recycled water when possible for construction activities & commercial power washing
- Reduce other indoor and outdoor water uses to minimize unnecessary loss of water.
