## Rebate Category (check the box which you are applying for):

**Single-Family Residential/Multi-Family with mixed use meters** (must be participating in Zone 7's Water Efficient Lawn (WEL) Conversion Rebate)

- Rebate of \$0.25 per square foot of eligible converted lawn - Maximum: 50% of material costs up to \$250.

**Commercial/Irrigation Meter Customers** (must be participating in Zone 7's Water Efficient Lawn (WEL) Conversion Rebate)

- Rebate of \$0.50 per square foot of eligible converted lawn – Maximum: 50% of material costs up to \$3,000.

## Application Checklist:

Lawn to be removed is currently in place, in a front yard/visible from sidewalk, and is in healthy condition\* (\*with the exception of drought conditions requiring restrictions to outdoor water use).

**To qualify for a rebate (please see Terms and Conditions for more information):**

- This offer applies only to the City of Pleasanton water customers who have an active water account(s) in good standing within the City of Pleasanton, and are participating in Zone 7's Water-Efficient Lawn Conversion Program\* (*\*exceptions may apply to irrigation metered customers*).
- Convert a *minimum* of 200 square feet of lawn visible from the sidewalk.
- The area to be converted is currently irrigated\* and the irrigation system is in good working condition (*\*exception provided under Drought Restrictions*).
- An irrigation system is not required in the converted area, however any existing overhead irrigation in the converted area must be removed or capped in place, or converted to a low volume drip. Low volume drip conversions must be equipped with proper backflow prevention, a rainfall shutoff valve, pressure regulator with filter, and pressure-compensating emitters.
- Plants installed in the converted area must be low or very low-water use and be listed on the City of Pleasanton [COP Qualifying Plant](#), [WUCOLS](#), [UC Davis Arboretum All-Stars](#), and/or [Tri-Valley Water-Wise Plant](#) lists.
- Qualified plants installed must cover at least 50% of the converted area when fully grown. **Non-permeable hardscape and artificial turf are not permitted in area to be rebated.**
- All projects must be approved and provided a Notice to Proceed from Zone 7 or the City of Pleasanton prior to removal of the lawn to be converted.
- During times of 40/60 prorated drought rebate modifications, elimination of lawn and mulch layer must be complete before issue of 40% of the rebate **within 120 days** of Notice to Proceed from Zone 7/City of Pleasanton. Upon notification from the City of Pleasanton that the planting stage may precede, the applicant has 120 days to complete installation according to approved plans to receive the remaining 60% of rebate balance.
- Conversion must remain installed for a minimum of two-years.

**Funding is limited. Rebates are one-time-only per site, and will be provided on a first-come, first served basis. Applications and receipts must be postmarked, or emailed within 60 days of purchase:**

I have voluntarily determined to participate in the City of Pleasanton's Water Efficient Landscape Program. I have independently selected materials, supplies and labor for the purpose of performing the installation. I agree that all work performed will comply with applicable state and local laws, ordinances and regulations. I agree that the City of Pleasanton may visit the premises and verify existing conditions and that the work has been performed. By virtue of these inspections, I understand that the City of Pleasanton makes no determination with respect to whether materials and equipment are free of defects, the quality of the workmanship, or the suitability of the premises or the materials or equipment for the installation. I also understand that the installation of irrigation equipment and landscape materials may not result in lower water bills. If this Application is approved by the City of Pleasanton and the work proceeds, I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Pleasanton, its directors, officers, agents and employees against any and all loss, liability, expense, claims, suits and damages, including attorneys' fees, arising out of or resulting from the installation of irrigation equipment and landscape materials. I agree to a pre- and/or post-installation inspection, upon request.
